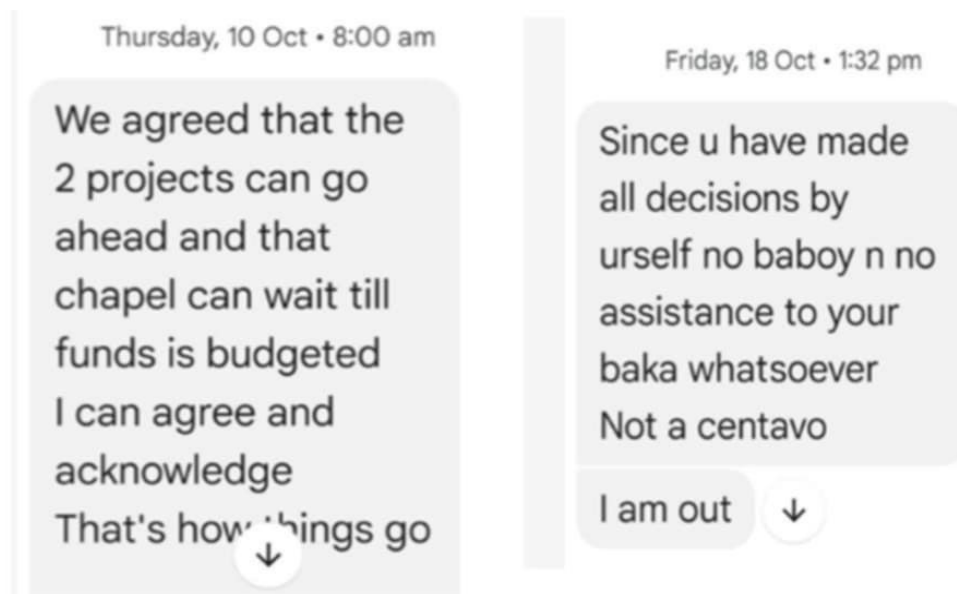


## Relationships: When Family Hurts

As the founder, owner, executive vice president and academic dean, from now on, I should run the affairs of the school including the finances.



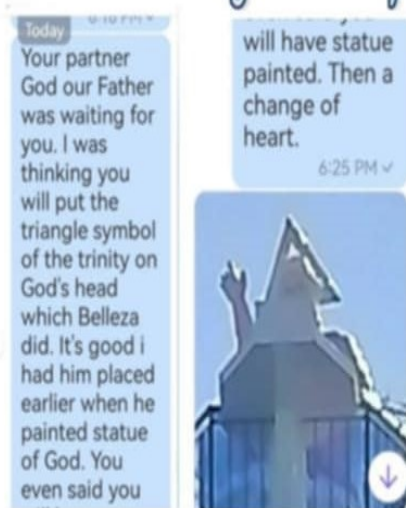
Danny, That's not how things go. Remember you are just God's creature.

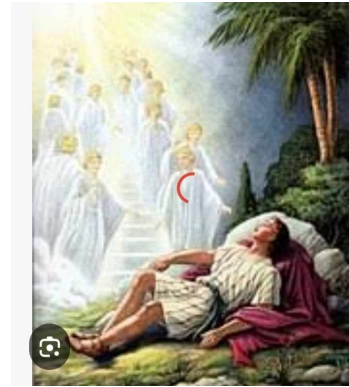
#### The Pendulum Damper

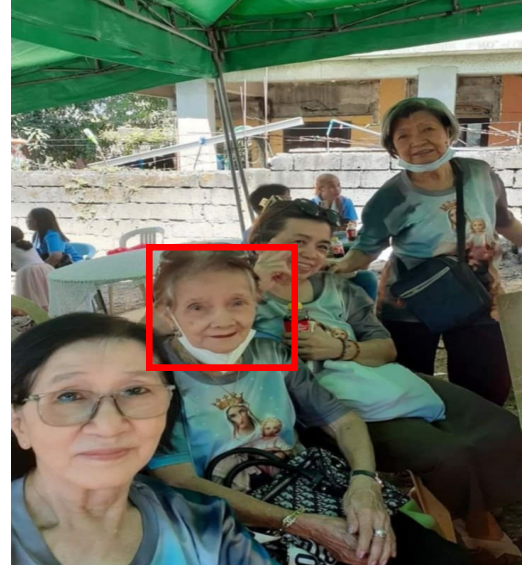
